Malaria is an ongoing fight in Kenya. The CDC says, "Insecticide-treated nets are one of the easiest and cheapest forms of personal protection that has been shown to reduce malaria illness, severe disease and death due to malaria epidemics." Statistics show that 3 out of 4 Kenyans are at risk of contracting malaria! Sadly only one in five Kenyans have a net, but HEART is working to protect our Orphans and Vulnerable Children! HEART has provided over 203,000 vulnerable families with malaria prevention nets. Help us fight malaria! The nets cost only \$10 each! we have a grant that provides for 500 nets a month but need another 300 monthly to keep up with the demand!
